(OSCC), IS A 501 © 3 NON-PROFIT PRIVATE ORGANIZATION WITH EIGHTEEN YEARS OF EXPERIENCE PROVIDING THE NECESSARY SERVICES (INCLUDING LIFE SKILL WORKSHOPS, PRE-EMPLOYMENT, VOCATIONAL TRAINING, REMEDIAL EDUCATION, JOB PLACEMENT, MENTORING, PARENTING, HEALTH PREVENTION, LEGAL, HOUSING AND FINANCIAL COUNSELING SERVICES) TO ENSURE THAT INDIVIDUALS, FAMILIES AND COMMUNITIES (INCLUDING OFFENDERS, EX-OFFENDERS “RETURNING CITIZENS”, FEMALE HEAD OF HOUSE, ELDERLY, LAID-OFF WORKERS, UNEMPLOYED AND OTHER DISADVANTAGED POPULATIONS) HAVE THE TOOLS NEEDED TO IMPROVE THEIR QUALITY OF LIFE AND TO USE A PROACTIVE APPROACH TO CREATE AN ISLAND-WIDE COLLABORATIVE SERVICE NETWORK FOR THE COMMUNITIES OF GREATEST NEED AND BETTERMENT OF OUR SOCIETY.

OSCC - PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

- HOUSING COUNSELING AGENCY APPROVED BY HUD TO ASSIST PROGRAM CLIENTS IN IMPROVING THEIR HOUSING CONDITIONS, MEETING THEIR FINANCIAL NEEDS, AND FULFILLING THE RESPONSIBILITIES` OF TENANCY OR HOMEOWNERSHIP.
- LEGAL REPRESENTATION AND ADVOCACY TO LOW INCOME 50 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WHO ARE FACING PROBLEMS WITH THEIR HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT.
- WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT TRAINING AND JOB PLACEMENT PROGRAM PROVIDE LOW- AND MODERATE-INCOME INDIVIDUALS WITH THE TOOLS THEY NEED TO IMPROVE THEIR OPPORTUNITY TO GAIN EMPLOYMENT AND HELP THEM ON A PATH TO ECONOMIC SELF-SUFFICIENCY.

OSCC - PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

- TRANSITIONAL AND POST-INCARCERATION REENTRY PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES SERVICES SUCH AS, JOB-READINESS, JOB PLACEMENT AND JOB RETENTION, INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP CAREER COUNSELING, REMEDIAL AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT SERVICES, INCLUDING MENTORING, PARENTING, HEALTH PREVENTION, AND FOLLOW-UP ASSESSMENTS SERVICES NECESSARY TO SUCCEED IN THE COMMUNITY AND AVOID RECIDIVISM.
- CONTINUUM OF CARE HEALTH MODEL - TRANSITIONAL HEALTH CARE COORDINATION FOR SOON TO BE RELEASE AND RELEASED RE-ENTRY CLIENTS TO IMPROVE HEALTH CARE ACCESS.
- COMMUNITY HOUSING DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION (CHDO) TO PROVIDE AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR LOW- AND VERY LOW-INCOME FAMILIES.

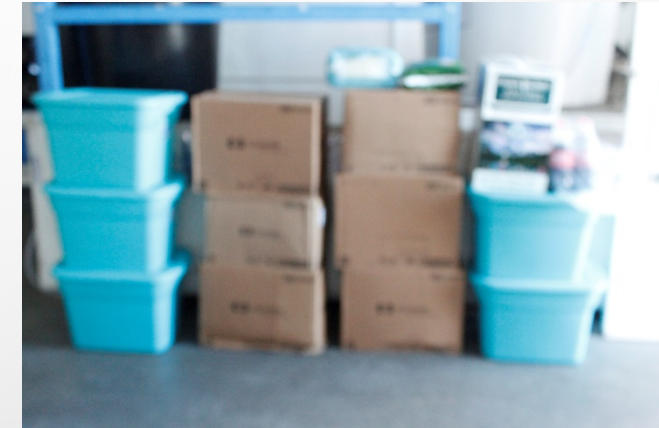

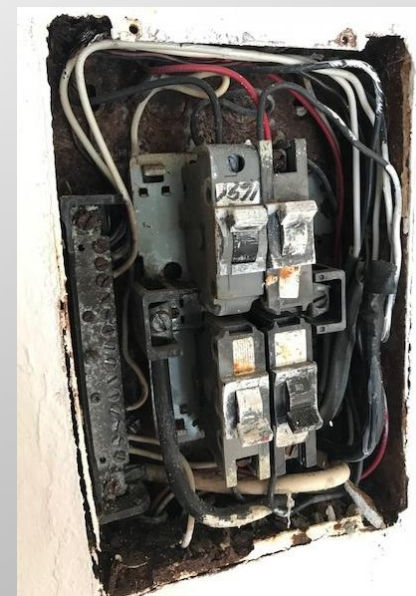

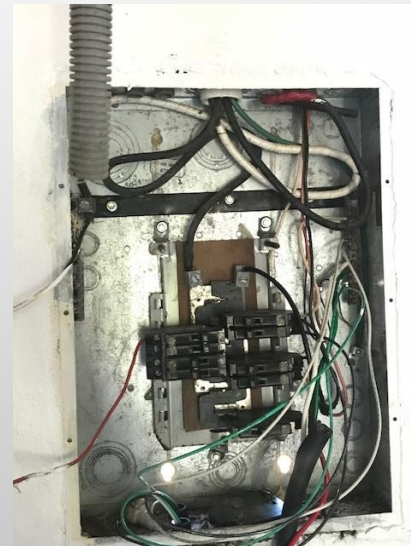

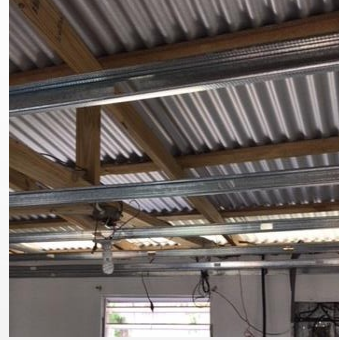

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE OCTOBER 2017

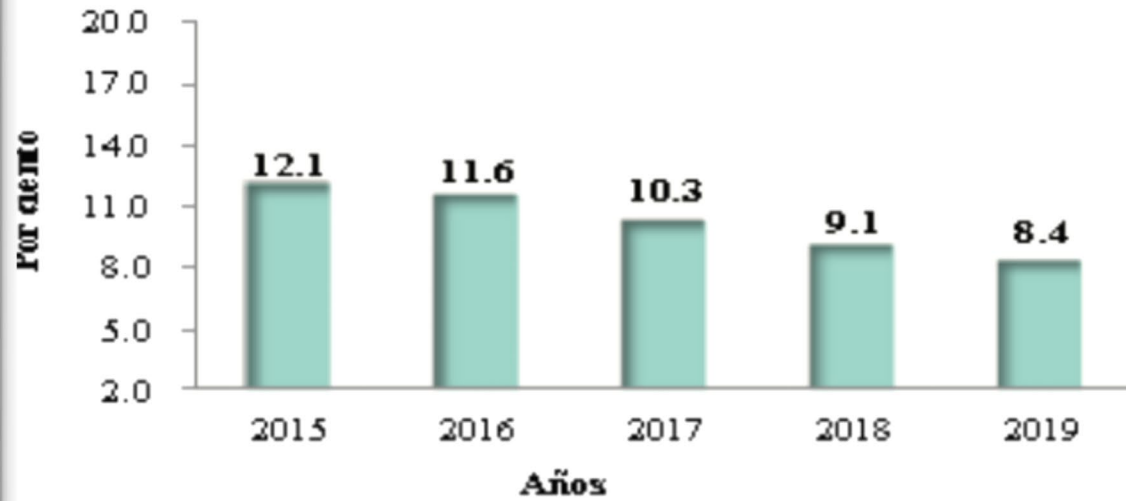
TASA DE DESEMPLIO EN OCTUBRE

WHAT ONE STOP NEEDS TO DO:

IN THE SHORT TERM:

- COMPLETE THE REPAIRS OF 26 RESIDENCES IN THE SOUTHERN AREA OF PUERTO RICO AFFECTED BY HURRICANE MARIA FROM FAMILIES WITH PROPERTY AND LOW INCOME AND DID NOT RECEIVE ANY ASSISTANCE OR ASSISTANCE WAS NOT ENOUGH.
- EMPLOY JUSTICE-INVOLVED PARTICIPANTS OF OUR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM IN THE REPAIRS OF RESIDENCES AFFECTED BY HURRICANE MARIA.
- CONTINUE HELPING HOMEOWNERS WITH MORTGAGE ARREARS TO AVOID FORECLOSURES.



IN THE MEDIUM AND LONG TERM:

- ACCESS FUNDS TO CONTINUE OFFERING THE SERVICES OF THE HOUSING COUNSELING, LEGAL SERVICES AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS.
- CONTINUE HELPING WITH HOME REPAIRS AS FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE.
- IMPLEMENT HOUSING COUNSELING CDBG-DR PROGRAM
